


#### Christmas Day Celebration (24 December 2019)

- 6. Dharana (Concentration): Concentration on a single point or object.
- 7. Dhyana (Meditation): Sustained concentration leading to a state of meditation.
- 8. Samadhi (Absorption): A state of ecstasy and ultimate union with the divine.

The talk covered how Ashtanga Yoga practices can be integrated into daily life to foster a well-rounded and balanced personality, touching on the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual aspects of personal growth.


#### Yoga Day Celebration (21 June 2021)




# International Day Of Awareness Of Food Loss And Waste Programme


## National Maths Day 24-Dec-21
